After you have had the opportunity to look at some of the resources we have recommended (or if you are using ones you have found yourself), we encourage you to reflect on what you would use to support your 'opening conversations'.

Reflection is an important part of your learning, so we would encourage you to think about the following before going forward with any issue-based delivery...

Some things to think about

- **Do you need a lot of knowledge? It is important to pick activities that are easy to facilitate and where young people learn from one another.**
- **Are there organisations in your community that may help you find more resources, such as your local NHS Health Improvement Team, local 3rd Sector or uniformed organisations? Are there any programmes/projects in your local learning community looking at GBV or related topics?**
- **Make sure you familiarise yourself with your organisation's safeguarding and child protection policies in case you receive any disclosures.**
- **Does the activity need a lot of prep time? if so, ensure you factor in enough time.**
- **Consider 'practising' delivering with a colleague/s?**
- **Is the session you are planning LGBTQ+ inclusive?**
- **Is your activity from a reliable source?**
- **Is the activity age and stage appropriate?**
